


SWINE & POULTRY BREEDS

AMERICAN LANDRACE

- ◉ Large Drooped ears
- ◉ Known for their maternal instincts
- ◉ White
- ◉ Long Bodied
- ◉ Flatter-topped than other breeds


BERKSHIRE

- Originated in England
- Black with white legs, snout and switch
- Once kept at Buckingham Palace
- Known for producing high quality meats
- Erect ears



CHESTER WHITE

- ◉ Originated in Chester County, Pennsylvania
- ◉ White with drooped ears
- ◉ Mothering breed
- ◉ Known to produce large litters




DUROC

- ◉ Originated in the United States
- ◉ Solid red or reddish brown.
- ◉ Drooped ears
- ◉ Slight dish to the face
- ◉ Excellent meat type hog

HAMPSHIRE

- ◉ Probably the oldest American breed
- ◉ Black with a white belt
- ◉ Small, erect ears
- ◉ Well-known meat breed

YORKSHIRE

- ◉ Originated in England.
- ◉ White pig with erect ears.
- ◉ Have large litters, and are good mothers.
- ◉ Rapid growing and long bodied.



POTBELLIED PIG

- ◉ Smaller than an average pig.
- ◉ Originated in Vietnam.
- ◉ Will grow into a “pig” do not stay small and cute.
- ◉ Popular “Fad” Pet
 - Many are abandoned after they reach mature size.



CORNISH CHICKEN

- ◉ Muscular Bird used for meat production
- ◉ Large Stocky bird
- ◉ Big wide spaced legs.
- ◉ Lays brown eggs



LEGHORN CHICKEN

- Excellent layers
- Originated from Italy
- 3 lbs to 4 lbs (Small)
- Used in commercial egg production
- White Eggs
- Yellow Skin
- Single Comb
- White Earlobes



RHODE ISLAND RED CHICKEN

- Popular dual purpose chicken.
- Used for Meat and Eggs
 - Lays Large Brown Eggs.
- Hardy Chicken
- Rust colored to dark maroon colored feathers.
- Yellow Feet




PLYMOUTH ROCK CHICKEN

- ◉ Dual Purpose
 - Good for eggs and Meat
- ◉ Brown Eggs
- ◉ Yellow Skin
- ◉ Red Earlobes
- ◉ Comes in multiple colors.
 - White
 - Barred
 - Buff
 - Black
 - And more...




DUCK

- ◉ Mostly aquatic
- ◉ Have elongated bodies and necks.
- ◉ One of the most numerous birds in North America.
- ◉ There are about 28 types in the U.S.



GEESE

- ◉ Waterfowl
- ◉ Have long necks
- ◉ Kept for meat, eggs, or feathers for down.
- ◉ Their eggs are larger and denser than chicken eggs but have a similar flavor.



QUAIL

- Raised for pets, feathers, eggs, or game hunting (Meat.)
- Small plump and round bird.
- Have a curved black crown feather.



TURKEY

- ⦿ Large birds used for meat and feathers.
- ⦿ Males have a wattle that hangs from the top of their beak.
- ⦿ Both wild and domestic turkeys.

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
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
